**Summary:** Using a bogus name, the League of Picklemakers, sixth grader Ben and three recruits start a prank-pulling club and receive funding from their middle school's PTA.

**Discussion Questions: Spoiler alert!** Some of the questions contain key elements of the plot. Do not read if you don't want to know what happens!

- 1. What do you think of the pranks? Are they well planned? What is the school's reaction? Which is your favorite prank?
- 2. How is each club member a good fit for the club? What does each member contribute?
- 3. What are some of the ways the club disguised themselves?
- 4. How do you feel about Hector being left out of the Pickle Club?
- 5. Was the principal fair? Why or why not?
- 6. Did Ben do the right thing by admitting to the pranks? Why did he choose to confess?

## **Activities:**

- Each member of the Pickle Club has unique qualities. Have readers think about what makes themselves unique. Draw a picture demonstrating their special skills. Write how they would be a valuable member to any club and what they would do to prove themselves.
- Create a new club. Make a club, tell what the club actually does, how they hide their identity, and who their members are. Draw a picture of the club members, location, or an activity they planned.
