

12 Days of Winter Break

Frozen Suncatchers

What You Need:

- any containers (ex. pie tins, cake pans, plastic containers)
- natural objects (ex. berries, leaves, twigs)
- water
- string
- food coloring (optional)

Instructions:

1. Arrange the natural objects in the container.
2. Pour water into the container. Add a few drops of food coloring if you wish.
3. Lay the center of the string into the water.
4. Place in the freezer until frozen.
5. Remove the suncatcher from the container and hang outdoors in a sunny spot. Depending on temperatures, they will slowly melt over the winter.

Tip:

Use only natural supplies that will naturally decompose over time.
