

15 Days of Winter Break

Crystal Snowflake

What You Need:

- pipe cleaner
- string
- pencil
- jar
- borax
- blue food coloring
- boiling water

Instructions:

1. Twist three 5-inch pieces of pipe cleaner together to form a snowflake, then add a 1 1/2-inch piece to each point.
2. Tie the snowflake with string to a pencil. Find a jar big enough so the suspended flake won't touch the sides.
3. Fill with 3 tablespoons borax and 1 drop blue food coloring per 1 cup of boiling water. Hang the snowflake in the jar. Let sit overnight. Remove.
