

15 Days of Winter Break

Sock Snowman

What You Need:

- white sock
- colored sock
- scissors
- filling, such as rice, cotton, or cloth scraps
- rubber bands
- markers or fabric paint
- optional glue (glue gun recommended)
- optional decorations, such as buttons, ribbons, and yarn

Instructions:

1. Turn the sock inside out and stuff it with your preferred filling. Use a rubber band to close off the opening.
2. Take a rubber band and loop it around the middle, closer to the top, to form the head. If the sock is big enough, use additional rubber bands to form other spheres.
3. Cut off the toe of the colored sock to make a hat for your snowman. If you want to, roll it up to create a rim and secure it to the head with glue.
4. If wanted, use the ribbon or yarn to make a scarf, or part of the colored sock to make a matching hat and scarf set.
5. If wanted, use glue to add buttons to snowman's torso.
6. Decorate your snowman! Use the fabric paint or markers to create eyes, a carrot nose, and a smile.

What else can you use to decorate your snowman? Q-tips or toothpicks for arms?
