

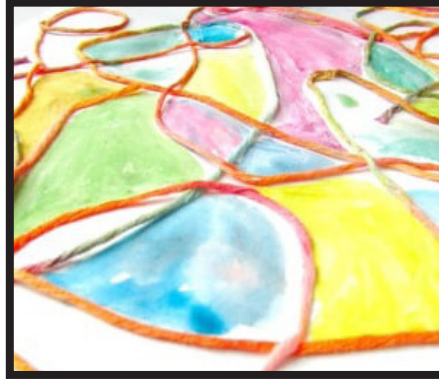
Watercolor Yarn

Materials Included:

- Yarn
- Glue
- Watercolors
- Paintbrush
- Paper

Materials Needed:

- Small bowl
- Water

Instructions:

1. Using the glue, make a loopy design on your paper.
2. Lay the yarn over the glue so you have many loops and unusual shapes. Don't worry if the glue smears over the paper, this will simply create different effects.
3. Allow the glue to completely dry, preferably overnight.
4. Once the yarn is stuck to the paper, you are ready to paint.
5. In a small bowl, add some water. Wet your paintbrush and add the watercolor.
6. Paint using various colors, shades, and combinations inside the different yarn shapes.
7. Experiment using different water to paint ratios.
8. Refresh your water as needed.
9. Allow watercolors to dry.
